PORT HOPE, C. W.—An incorporated Town beautifully situated on Lake Ontario, in the Township of Hope and County of Durham. The Grand Trunk Railway has a station at this place. The Port Hope, Lindsay, and Beaverton Railroad, which is near completion, will open up a rapidly progressing agricultural back country; and this, combined with the works now in progress towards forming the harbor a port of refuge during storms, will have the effect of making Port Hope one of the principal outlets on Lake Ontario for the shipping of the products of the back settlements. The principal articles of export for the year 1856 were 80,397 bushels wheat and 6,477 barrels flour. Distant from Cobourg 7 miles, from Toronto 63 miles, from Peterborough 29 miles, from Lindsay 42 miles, and from Kingston 98 miles. Daily mail. Population about 5000.
